

Do These Activities to Get Paid Benefits



Unemployed workers who do the following activities are far more likely to avoid interruption and receive timely payment of needed benefits.

1 File Weekly Claims

You need to file a claim every week. If you do not file you cannot be paid. File earlier in the week to get paid sooner. It is easier to file online at www.GetKansasBenefits.gov than it is to file by phone.

2 Complete All Paperwork

Complete and return all paperwork sent to you by the due date. For example, the My Reemployment Plan included with this mailing must be returned within seven (7) days or needed benefits will stop.

3 Look for Work

Unemployment benefits are temporary. Workers who conduct an active work search are far more likely to find their next job before benefits run out. Apply for at least two jobs every week, and do at least one other job seeking activity (sign up for social networking, browse job postings, go to job fairs, etc.). Successful job seekers keep a log to track their activities.

4 Get Reemployment Services

Claimants who receive reemployment services are more likely to get back to work sooner. Reemployment services are free of charge to all claimants from your local Workforce Center. We may schedule you for reemployment services. If you receive a scheduling letter, you must attend and participate in these services.
